Description:

Original document consisting of three pages (straight verse) and one page (verse), of the type Contract of Sale, in handwritten text format, dated 28 March 1801. It deals with a notarial transaction under a contract of sale of a part of the Moquegua estate between Mr. Anselmo Balois (seller) and the lieutenant of Dragons Mr. Antonio Barrios (buyer), for 4228 pesos and 3.5 reales; issued by the notary public Joseph Fernández Dávila. On the first page, as part of the stamp, there is a chrismon with the inscription: "DOCE REALES / SELLO SEGUNDO, DOCE REALES, / AÑOS DE MIL SEVENIENOS NOVENTA Y OCHO, Y NOVEN Y / NUEVA. / PARA LOS AÑOS DE 1800 Y 1801"; on the left margin, royal oval stamp with the inscription: "CAROLUS IV D.G HISPANIAR.REX"; on the left margin, the designation of the documentary type. The following bifolio (second sheet in verse and third sheet in straight) has a seam, iron gall ink imprints and cut edges. The third page in verse also shows the iron gall ink in the writing, the autograph and the sign that identifies Joseph Fernández Dávila as the Public and Town Council Notary. The next page, in straight line, presents the sign of the scribe followed by a blank space and, in verse, in the upper right part, it shows the following writing: "Compra de la pa de Hazda de mi hermano / D. Anselmo Valois", the rest of the page is blank with traces of ink migration and oxidation of the support.

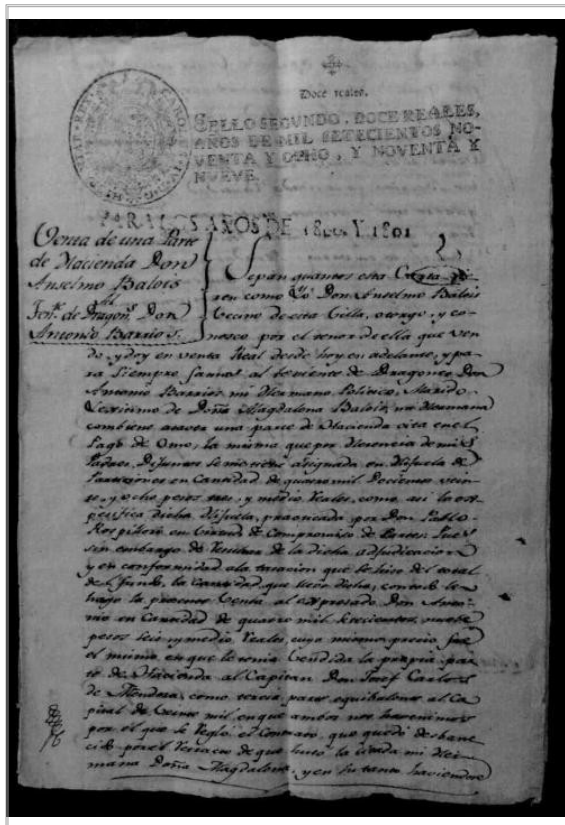


Image: View of 1st page

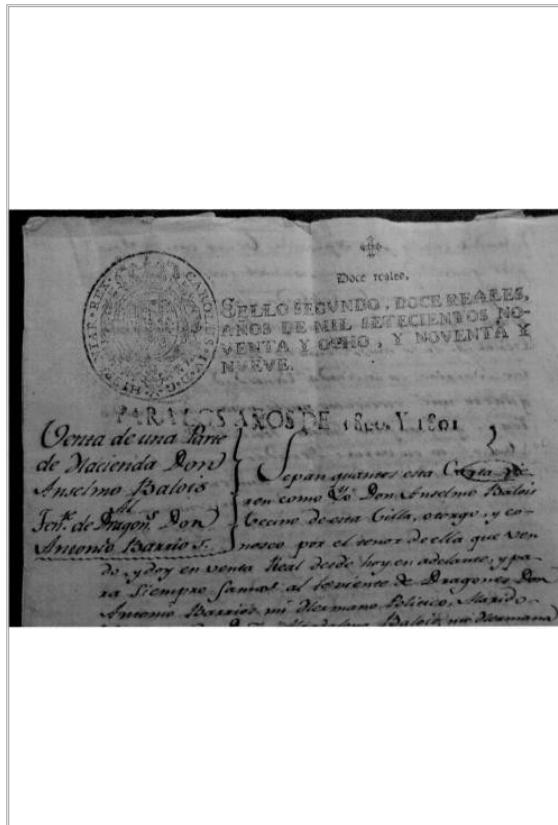


Image: 1st page detail

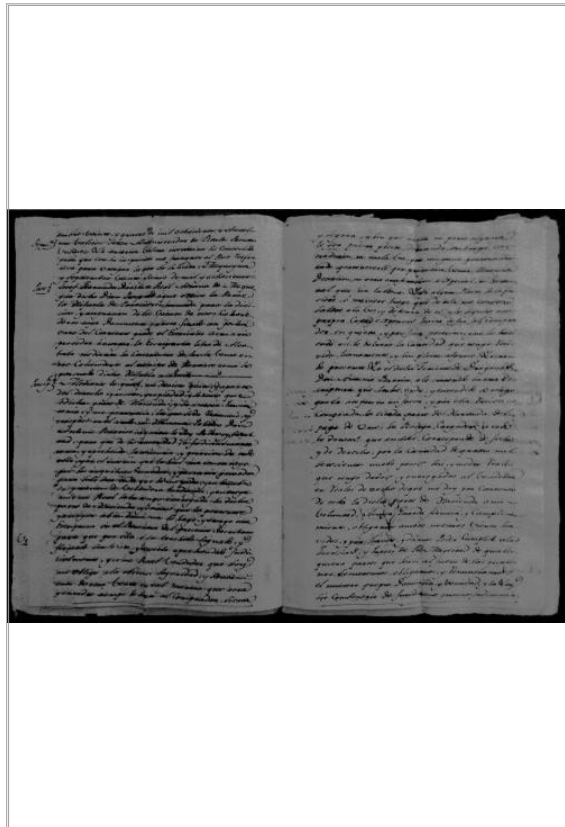


Image: 2nd (verse) and 3rd (straight) page

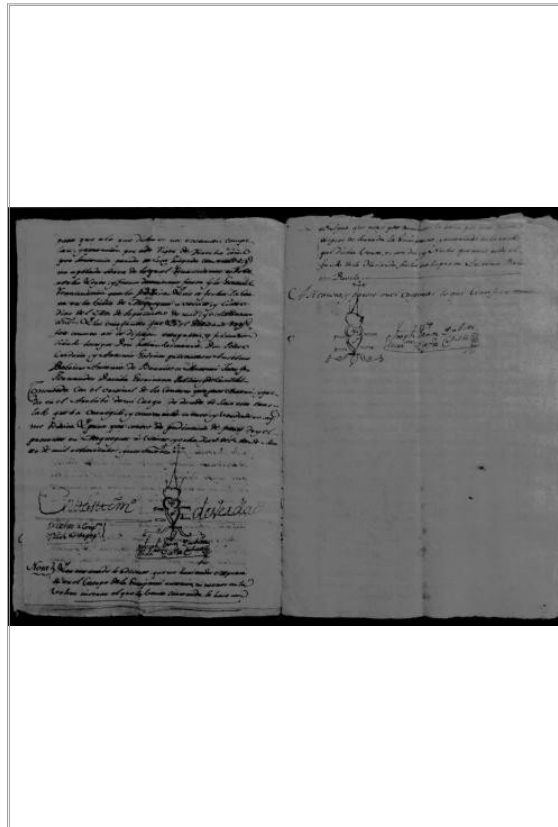


Image: 3rd (verse) and last (straight) page
